Short description: C-GEOW, a Pilatus PC-12/45 aircraft operated by North Star Air, was con-

ducting a flight from Sioux Lookout (CYXL), ON to Kasabonika (CYAQ), ON with 2 pilots and 5 passengers on board. During the landing on Runway 03, the aircraft experienced a runway excursion when it overran the end of the runway. The aircraft came to rest approximately 350 feet past the departure end of the runway was substantially damaged. The pilots and passengers were uninjured. The Emergency Locator Transmitter

(ELT) activated.
