Short description: The single-engine turboprop aircraft took off from Buochs (LSZC), Switzer-

land, for a flight to Burg Feuerstein (EDQE) in Germany. It departed from runway 24 under visual flight rules with a planned transition to instrument flight rules later on. After approximately three minutes of flight time, the aircraft crashed into Lake Lucerne north of Bürgenstock and sank. The pilot

was uninjured; the passenger suffered injuries.
