Short description: During the landing on runway 03L at Las Palmas de Gran Canaria Airport

(GCLP) of an AIRBUS A320N, a formation of four military F16 aircraft

(PROTE75) was authorized to take off from runway 03R.

When the Airbus was already on final approach, three of the four F16 took off, and upon the fourth taking off, a loss of separation occurred.
