
Short description of the incident: During the approach at approximately 1000 ft above

ground the aircraft veered 45 degrees to the left. With the application of full right rudder the aircraft could be

landed on the runway 16.

After the landing it appeared that the on the left side the rod of the inner spoiler actuator was broken and

the spoiler was partially deployed.



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Reason:

After the incident the technical problem appeared immediately. Therefore the investigation has been focused on the technical content. Immediate inspections, the issuance of service bulletins and an airworthiness directive (EASA AD 2006-139) were the results. In the meantime, the technical issue has been addressed fleet-wide by the authorities, manufacturers and operators. Therefore the Swiss AAIB decided to cease the investigation.
