**Short description:** With slippery conditions on taxiway and ramp, the aircraft with both engines switched off, was pulled by a tow truck (noselift truck) towards its parking position. During a turn, the tow truck started skidding and eventually slipped below the fuselage of the aircraft, damaging the lower fuselage part and an antenna of the aircraft.
