Short description:		The aircraft departed from Pending Airstrip with intended destination of Sentani International Airport. After two missed approaches at Sentani due to weather condition, the flight diverted to Senggeh Airport. About 6 Nm northwest Senggeh Airport, the aircraft made an emergency landing on an unpaved road, due to fuel exhaustion. The aircraft is severely damaged.
