Short description: The recording shows that the aircraft was established on the inbound ra-

dial of the VOR APP 07L and was cleared approach. But SWR74L started the descend below 2000 ft before the FAF and when reaching 1000 ft just before the FAF, the crew noticed their mistake and initiated

the missed approach. This happened in VMC.
